1.  - a) *Prior to the meeting, or during the meeting prior to an agenda item being discussed, any person wishing to address the Planning Commission shall complete a speaker card and submit it to the Planning Manager. Speaker cards are available in the foyer of the City Council Chambers and from the Minutes Clerk.*
 - b) *When called upon, the person shall come to the podium, state his/her name and address for the record, and, if speaking for an organization or other group, identify the organization or group represented. Whenever any group of persons wishes to address the Planning Commission on the same subject matter, the Chair may, at his/her discretion, request that the group choose a spokesperson to address the Commission.*
 - c) *All remarks should be addressed to the Planning Commission as a whole, and not to individual Commissioners. Questions, if any, should be directed to the presiding Chair who will determine whether, or in what manner, an answer will be provided.*
 - d) *Every person addressing the Planning Commission will be limited to three (3) minutes or such reasonable time as is granted by the majority of the Planning Commission.*

2. TIME EXTENSION (TX 09-007):

Project Description:

A Conditional Use Permit (CUP 09-008) to allow a non-emergency ambulance services use within an existing multi-tenant industrial building located within the M-1 (Light Industrial) zone. Pursuant to the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA-Public Resources Code, Section 21084 et. Seq.), this project meets the requirements for a categorical exemption in compliance with Section 15301, (Class 1-Existing Facilities).

Recommended Action:
