 - b) *When called upon, the person shall come to the podium, state his/her name and address for the record, and, if speaking for an organization or other group, identify the organization or group represented. Whenever any group of persons wishes to address the Planning Commission on the same subject matter, the Chair may, at his/her discretion, request that the group choose a spokesperson to address the Commission.*
 - c) *All remarks should be addressed to the Planning Commission as a whole, and not to individual Commissioners. Questions, if any, should be directed to the presiding Chair who will determine whether, or in what manner, an answer will be provided.*
 - d) *Every person addressing the Planning Commission will be limited to three (3) minutes or such reasonable time as is granted by the majority of the Planning Commission.*

Project Description:

The applicant is proposing a Conditional Use Permit Modification request to allow an extension of closing hours from 10:30 p.m. to 2:00 a.m., Friday and Saturday for an existing restaurant. Pursuant to the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA-Public Resources Code, Section 21084 et. Seq.), this project meets the requirements for a categorical exemption in compliance with Article 19, Section 15301, (Class 1 – Existing Facilities).

Recommended Action:

The Planning Division recommends that the Planning Commission adopt the attached Resolution approving Conditional Use Permit Modification (CUPM 06-005), subject to conditions.

The applicant is proposing an Oak Tree Permit to allow relocation of 6 oak trees and removal of 3 oak trees at the Los Angeles County Fairgrounds. Pursuant to the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA-Public Resources Code, Section 21084 et. Seq.), this project meets the requirements for a categorical exemption in compliance with Article 19, Section 15304, (Class 4 – Minor Alterations to Land).

Recommended Action:

The Planning Division recommends that the Planning Commission continue the item to June 24, 2009.

3. CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CUP 09-002):

Project Description:

The applicant is proposing a Conditional Use Permit for an off-sale beer and wine (Type-20) alcohol license for an existing 7-Eleven convenience store with a gas service station on a (1.24-acre) lot in the C-2 (Neighborhood Shopping Center) zone. Pursuant to the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA-Public Resources Code, Section 21084 et. Seq.), this project meets the requirements for a categorical exemption in compliance with Article 18, Section 15270, CEQA does not apply to projects that are disapproved.

Recommended Action:

The Planning Division recommends that the Planning Commission adopt the attached Resolution denying Conditional Use Permit (CUP 09-002).
