

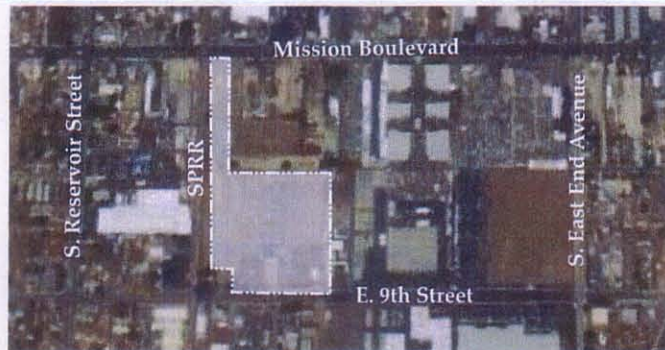

Project Title: Pomona Valley Transfer Station Project

Project Location - City: Pomona

Project Location - County: Los Angeles

Project Location - Specific: The approximately 10.5-acre Project site (illustrated below) is located at 1371 East 9th Street, and is bounded by Mission Boulevard to the north, existing commercial and industrial buildings to the east, East 9th Street to the south, and Southern Pacific Railroad tracks to the west.



Project Description: The Pomona Valley Transfer Station Project proposes construction and operation of an approximately 61,870 square foot, privately owned and operated municipal solid waste (MSW) transfer station building, together with ancillary administrative, maintenance, and operational facilities. Revised Draft Environmental Impact Report (Revised DEIR) Section 3.0, "Project Description," presents a complete detailed description of the Project.

A March 2010 DEIR for the Pomona Valley Transfer Station Project (March 2010 Draft EIR) was circulated for public review and comment during the period March 23, 2010 through May 6, 2010. Based on comments received, the City of Pomona, acting as the Lead Agency, has determined that recirculation of this *Revised* [emphasis added] Draft Environmental Impact Report for the Pomona Valley Transfer Station Project (Revised Draft EIR) will be of benefit in providing on-point responses to comments as well as correction, clarification, and amplification of information provided previously in the March 2010 Draft EIR.

Significant Effects Discussed in the Revised DEIR: Analysis presented in the Revised DEIR indicates that the Project will have certain significant traffic, air quality, and noise impacts, as described in detail in Revised DEIR Sections 4.2, 4.3, and 4.4, respectively. As identified in Revised DEIR Section 5.0, cumulative impacts related to traffic, air quality, and noise are also considered to be significant. The Revised DEIR presents mitigation measures that, to the extent feasible, will reduce Project-specific and cumulative traffic, air quality, and noise impacts. All other environmental effects evaluated in the Revised DEIR are considered to be less than significant, or can be mitigated below significance thresholds.
