POMONA, CA – On March 13, 2020 at 4:30 p.m., Mayor Sandoval called for an Emergency Closed Session Meeting to be held via teleconference in accordance with the Executive Order issued by California Governor Newsom with respect to the COVID-19 pandemic (Coronavirus). On a vote of 7-0, Mayor Sandoval and Councilmembers approved to authorize the City Manager to take immediate action to protect the public health and safety of employees and the public by modifying or closing access to public facilities, including city hall among others.

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY all City of Pomona facilities, including community centers and the Pomona Public Library, will be closed to the public until further notice. Additional information will be provided at a later date.
